## LICENCES ACT

*(CAP 113)***Licences (Miscellaneous Services) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Licences Act, the Minister responsible for finance makes the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Licences (Miscellaneous Service) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021. Citation

2. The Licences (Miscellaneous) Regulations are amended as follow — S.I. 33 of 2000

- (a) in regulation 2 by repealing the definition of “refrigeration mechanic or technician” and substituting therefor the following definition —

““refrigeration mechanic or technician” means a person who has successfully completed an approved training course from an approved national training centre for the installation, repair, servicing and maintenance of refrigeration equipment including decommissioning ozone depleting substances.”

- (b) Schedule 1 to the Licences (Miscellaneous) Regulations is amended under the heading “Refrigeration Mechanic or Technician Documents” as follow —

- (i) in clause (a) in sub-clause (i) by repealing the words “issued by the Industrial

Training Centre” and substituting therefor the following —

“issued by a nationally approved training centre”;

(ii) by inserting immediately after clause (c) the following new clauses —

“(d) in the case of a contractor, a certificate in hydro-carbon training recognized by the nationally approved centre.

(e) an individual, a partner, a contractor or a natural person who is practising as a refrigeration mechanic or technician who has not successfully completed an approved training course from an approved national training centre shall continue to do so for a period not exceeding 18 months from the date of commencement of these regulations.”
