PASSPORT ACT

(Cap 155)

Passport (Amendment) Regulations, 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Passport Act (Cap 155), the Minister of Internal Affairs, hereby makes the following regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Passport (Amendment) Regulations, 2022.

Amendment of regulations

- 2. The Passport Regulations, 1976 is amended as follows
 - (a) by inserting in regulation 2 before the definition of "diplomatic passport" the following definitions —

"biometric passport" means a passport which contains unique biological data specific to the holder";

"biological data" includes —

- (*i*) a person's fingerprint or handprint (taken using paper and ink, digital scanning technologies or otherwise);
- *(ii)* a photograph or other image of a person's face and shoulders;
- (iii) a person's signature; and
- *(iv)* an image of a person's iris (taken using iris scanning technologies."; and

- (b) by inserting in regulation 3 after the words "First Schedule to these Regulations" the words "or biometric passport".
