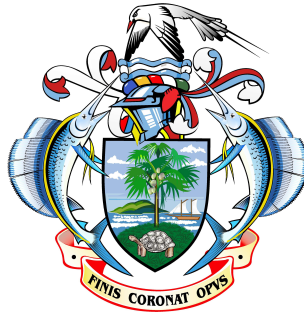

FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ASSOCIATIONS ACT, 2022.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Associations (Amendment) Act, 2023.

Repeal of section 1

2. Section 1 of the Associations Act, 2022 is repealed and substituted with the following new section —

“Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Associations Act, 2022 and shall come into operation on such day as the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette appoint, and different dates may be appointed for different provisions of the Act.”
