## CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT ACT 2011

*(Act 22 of 2011)***Customs Management (Prohibited and Restricted Goods)  
Regulations, 2023**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 270 of the Customs Management Act read with section 63, the Minister of Finance, National Planning and Trade hereby makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibited and Restricted Goods) Regulations, 2023.

**Interpretation**

2. In these Regulations —

“Authority” in respect of restricted goods, means the Authority specified under column (1) of the Second Schedule;

“prohibited goods” means any goods specified under the First Schedule or the importation of which are prohibited under a written law; and

“restricted goods” means any goods specified under the Second Schedule and the importation of which are not prohibited by a written law but for the importation of which a written prior approval of the Authority specified under these Regulations is required.

**Prohibited goods**

3. The goods specified under the First Schedule are prohibited goods and shall not be imported into Seychelles.

**Restricted goods**

4.(1) The goods specified under the Second Schedule are restricted goods.

(2) The import of the goods specified under sub regulation (1) shall be subject to the prior approval of the Authority specified in the Second Schedule.

(3) A person importing any goods specified under column (2), the HS Code and description of which are given in column (3) and (4) respectively, of the Second Schedule shall, prior to the import of such goods into Seychelles, obtain approval in writing from the Authority specified in the corresponding entry under column (1) of that Schedule.

### Repeal of S.I. 41 of 2019

5. The Customs Management (Prohibited and Restricted Goods) Regulations, 2019 (S.I.41 of 2019) are hereby repealed.
