COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT (Cap.39)

APPOINTMENT OF A COMMISSION OF INQUIRY BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SEYCHELLES

WHEREAS section 2(1)(d) of the Commission of Inquiry Act, (Cap.39) confers upon the President the power to issue a Commission appointing one or more Commissioners to inquire into any matter of public interest or concern;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to a lease agreement dated 5 July 2024, the Republic of Seychelles leased Assumption Island to Island Development Company Limited for a term of ninety-nine (99) years commencing on 1 July 2024;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to a sublease agreement dated 18 September 2024, entered into between Island Development Company Limited, Ocean Breeze Investments Limited, and the Republic of Seychelles, pursuant to which Island Development Company Limited, with the consent and agreement of the Republic of Seychelles, subleased a portion of Assumption Island to Ocean Breeze Investments Limited;

AND WHEREAS, the subleased portion, as defined in the sublease agreement, comprises a minimum area of 400,000 square meters, which is delineated in the plan annexed as Annexure 1 to the said sublease agreement.

AND WHEREAS Ocean Breeze Investments Limited is widely recognised and publicly regarded as an entity representing another state or its ruling family, or is ultimately beneficially owned by another state or members of its ruling family;

AND WHEREAS, subsequent to the said sublease, developments have been initiated on Assumption Island pursuant to the sublease;

AND WHEREAS the said sublease and the subsequent development activities on Assumption Island have been the subject of significant public discourse, concern, and speculations regarding the propriety, legality, and transparency of the processes involved including the aspect of environmental protection;

AND WHEREAS it is in the public interest, including for the purpose of fostering public confidence in the institutions of governance and the administration of public affairs of Seychelles, that a comprehensive, independent, and impartial inquiry be conducted to establish the facts and circumstances pertaining to the negotiation and execution of the said sublease and its related developments;

AND WHEREAS I, Dr Mathew Antonio Patrick Herminie, President of the Republic of Seychelles, am satisfied that the matter and circumstances relating to the sublease of Assumption Island by Island Development Company Limited, with the consent and agreement of the Republic of Seychelles, to Ocean Breeze Investments Limited, and the subsequent developments of the island by Ocean Breeze Investments Limited, are of vital public interest and concern;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dr Mathew Antonio Patrick Herminie, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 2(1) of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1962 do hereby appoint, constitute, and issue as follows:

ARTICLE 1

INTERPRETATION

In this Instrument, unless the context otherwise requires, -

"ASSOMPTION ISLAND" means the island of Assumption, forming part of the territory of the Republic of Seychelles;

"DEVELOPMENTS" means all developments initiated on Assumption Island subsequent to the execution of the Sublease;

"SUBLEASE" means the authentic sublease agreement dated 18 September 2024, entered into between Island Development Company Limited, Ocean Breeze Investments Limited, and the Republic of Seychelles, pursuant to which Island Development Company Limited, with the consent and agreement of the Republic of Seychelles, subleased a portion of Assumption Island to Ocean Breeze Investments Limited;

"REPUBLIC" means the Republic of Seychelles.

ARTICLE 2

ISSUE OF A COMMISSION AND APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS

- 2.1. There shall be a Commission of Inquiry known as the Commission of Inquiry into the Sublease and Development of Assumption Island (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission").
- 2.2. The Commission shall consist of a sole Commissioner, Justice, Dr. Mathilda Twomey.

ARTICLE 3

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Commission is hereby mandated and required to inquire into the following matters and to report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to my office-

3.1. **The Origin and Execution of the Sublease**

- (a) The comprehensive history and factual context relating to the subleasing of Assumption Island, or any part thereof. This shall consider any initial expressions of interest, the negotiations between the respective parties to the Sublease, and the formal execution of the Sublease.
- (b) Any relevant events, decisions, or matters prior or subsequent to the execution of the Sublease that have a bearing on its implementation or impact. This shall include discussions between the Government of the Seychelles, Island Development Company Limited and any other relevant third parties that may be relevant to the entering into or execution of the Sublease.

3.2 **Parties and Negotiators**

To identify and investigate the roles of all parties, persons, officials, intermediaries, and advisers involved, directly or indirectly, in the negotiations in respect of to the granting and execution of the Sublease.

3.3. **Planning and Ancillary Permissions**

- (a) The circumstances, processes, and procedures under which planning permission and any other ancillary permissions, licenses, or approvals were granted in respect of any developments on Assumption Island. This shall include but is not limited to whether an application for relevant environmental authorisations,

permissions or approvals was made as part of the planning application and how that application was assessed.

- (b) The subsequent monitoring and enforcement of the developments by the Planning Authority and any other relevant public authority.
- (c) Whether any illegal or undue interference, pressure, or influence was exerted upon the officers or the Board of the Planning Authority or any other relevant Ministry, department, agency of other public body by the political or administrative leadership of the Republic, or by any other person, to secure relevant planning permissions, any other ancillary permissions, licences or approvals, or to influence any subsequent monitoring by those organisations.

3.4. **Compliance with Law and Permissions**

Whether the developments on Assumption Island have been conducted in compliance with the laws of Seychelles, including but not limited to compliance with all relevant and applicable laws governing or relating to the employment of non-Seychellois, and with all the terms and conditions of planning permissions granted by the Planning Authority and other relevant permissions, approvals or licences.

3.5. **Environmental and Ecological Impact**

- (a) The impact, both actual and projected, that the developments have had and will have on the environment and ecology of Assumption Island itself.
- (b) The impact, both actual and projected, that the developments have had and will have on the environment and ecology of the surrounding areas, including but not limited to the ocean around Assumption Island, with particular attention on the UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Aldabra Atoll.
- (c) To identify all parties and persons involved directly or indirectly in the environmental and ecological decision-making processes regarding the development, how that process was undertaken, and whether any of the circumstances referred to in Article 3.3(c) obtained in respect of any environmental approvals, authorisations or permissions that were granted in favour of the developments.

3.6. **International Flights**

- (a) Whether any international flights have landed on or taken off from Assumption Island since the entering into of the Sublease, and if so, to establish the full

circumstances under which such flights were authorised, including which entities or persons granted such authorisation and for what purpose.

- (b) Whether there has been any illegal or undue interference, pressure, or influence exerted upon the officers of the relevant aviation or security authorities by the political or administrative leadership of the Republic, or by any other person, to secure the authorisation for such international flights.

3.7. Transparency, Legality, and Financial Probity

- (c) Whether the procedures for granting the Sublease and related planning permissions were followed lawfully, fairly, and transparently. This includes, but is not limited to, the granting of gainful occupational permits to non-Seychellois employees of Ocean Breeze Investments Limited or its associates.
- (d) Having regard to all of the circumstances which led to the entering into of the Sublease, including any commercial negotiations between the respective parties, to examine the commercial rationale for the Sublease and assess whether the agreed rent represents fair market value. The investigation will determine if the terms secured are commercially prudent and serve the best financial interests of the Republic of Seychelles.
- (e) To establish whether there were any undue payments, bribes, kickbacks, or other illicit benefits effected to anyone in connection with the granting or entering into of the Sublease or in relation to the developments.
- (f) If any such undue payments, bribes, kickbacks, or other illicit benefits are found to have been made, to establish the source, destination, and routing of such payments, bribes, kickbacks, or other illicit benefits, and to identify the individuals and entities who have solicited, received, or benefited from them.

3.8. The Visit of President Ramkalawan to the Maldives

To inquire into any potential connection, influence, or relevance between an official visit undertaken by the then President of the Republic, Wavel Ramkalawan, to the Republic of the Maldives from 11 June to 14 June 2023, and the granting of the Sublease or any decisions related thereto.

3.9. Sovereignty over Assomption Island Post-Sublease

To determine whether any abdication of the Republic's sovereignty over Assomption Island has occurred subsequent to the execution of the Sublease.

ARTICLE 4**POWERS AND PROCEDURE****4.1. Powers of the Commission**

The Commission shall, for the purpose of its inquiry, have all the powers conferred upon a Commission by the Commission of Inquiry Act, including the power to-

- (a) summon any person to attend before it to give evidence or to produce any document or thing in their possession;
- (b) examine witnesses and parties concerned on oath, affirmation or declaration, as the case may be;
- (c) receive evidence by affidavit or administer interrogatories, where the Commissioner considers it desirable for the purpose of avoiding expense or delay or for any other special reason; and
- (d) do all such other things as are necessary for the proper fulfillment of its mandate, including the power to require the production of any relevant documents or information.

4.2. Assistance to Commission

The Commission may engage and appoint such legal, technical, financial, asset tracing and environmental experts, and other experts as it deems necessary to assist in its work and to provide expert opinion and analysis on any matters within the Terms of Reference specified in Article 3.

4.3. Proceedings of Commission

The proceedings of the Commission shall be held in public, save for where the Commission, for reasons of national security, the protection of witnesses, or the administration of justice, determines that certain proceedings should be held in camera.

ARTICLE 5**REPORT**

The Commission shall submit to my office a final written report of its inquiry, including its findings of fact, its conclusions on the matters specified in the Terms of Reference specified in Article 3, and any recommendations it considers appropriate, within a

period of six months from the date of its first sitting, or such further period as I may subsequently authorise upon a request by the Commission.

DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT ACT, 2014

(Act 15 of 2014)

Reconstitution of the Disaster Risk Management Division as a Department

WHEREAS, the Disaster Risk Management Division was established under section 3 of the Disaster Risk Management Act, 2014 (Act 15 of 2014);

AND, WHEREAS, the Cabinet has approved the change of the title of office from “Disaster Risk Management Division” to the “Department of Risk and Disaster Management” in order to strengthen the national disaster governance, enhance policy authority and improve the operational coordination of the Disaster Risk Management activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred section 39 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act (Cap. 103) read with section 3 of the Disaster Risk Management Act, 2014 (Act 15 of 2014), the President of the Republic of Seychelles hereby declares as follows:—

- 1. Change of the name of the Division:** The Disaster Risk Management Division, established under section 3 of the Disaster Risk Management Act, 2014 (Act 15 of 2014) is hereby renamed as the Department of Risk and Disaster Management (DRDM) under the portfolio of the Vice-President.
- 2. Change of the title of the Head of Department:** The title of the post of “Director General” is hereby changed as “Principal Secretary” and the Principal Secretary of the Department of Risk and Disaster Management is hereby designated as the Head of the Department.
- 3. Change in the statutory references:** Until such time, the Disaster Risk Management Act, 2014 (Act 15 of 2014) is amended, all references to “Director General” in the Act or in any other written law, shall be read as “Principal Secretary” and all statutory functions, duties, and powers assigned to the Director General under the Disaster Risk Management Act, 2014 (Act 15 of 2014), shall be exercised by the Principal Secretary.
- 4. Effective Date:** This notice shall take effect on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
